

Ask your National Commander!

Welcome to the "Ask your Commander" corner! Each month, we will dedicate time to answer questions that we most commonly receive. If you have a questions, please send it to us at dava@dav.org. No question is too big or too small.

Q: Who are the authorized signers on unit bank account(s)?

A: The Treasurer establishes and maintains a bank account in the name of the Unit, Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary. The three required authorized Unit signatures shall be the Commander, Senior Vice Commander, and Treasurer.

Q: Who can contact the bank concerning the unit bank account?

A: Any of the three authorized account signers have the authority to check or review the account status.

Q: Can a grandchild of a disabled veteran apply for the DAV Auxiliary Scholarship or Vocational/Training Assistance Reimbursement Program?

A: A grandchild may apply for the Education Scholarship. Applicants for the Vocational/Training Assistance Reimbursement Program must be a disabled veteran, their spouse or child. (See pages 37-38 in the Procedure and Program Manual for requirements and information for application forms or call the National DAVA office.)

Q: Can units have debit cards or credit cards?

A: No. Debit/credit cards may not be used.

Q: If our unit has internal problems, who can we contact for guidance?

A: Even though this question was answered last month, it is worth reiterating. The unit should always follow the chain of command. If the issue cannot be resolved at the unit level, the auxiliary state department should be contacted. Should a state department not be able to resolve the issue, it should then be brought to the attention of national headquarters. Any request should be submitted in writing with as much detail as possible.

Past National Commander Barbara Maldet

DAV Auxiliary Past National Commander Barbara Maldet of Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania, passed away September 3, 2021. She help many unit, state, and national offices culminating in her 1992 election to the organization's highest office at the 70th national convention in Reno, Nevada.

After joining DAV Auxiliary in 1980, Barbara became mindful of the needs of disabled veterans and their families and, along with her husband, Joseph, a U.S. Navy veteran, worked tirelessly to carry out the DAV/DAV Auxiliary mission. While her husband served as State Adjutant for the DAV State Department of Pennsylvania, she became their office manager, a position she held for ten years. Later, she was appointed Administrative Assistant at the DAV Auxiliary national headquarters office in Cold Spring, Ky.



Always possessing a fervency for compassion, Mrs. Maldet was a registered nurse and prior to her involvement in DAV/DAV Auxiliary, she cared for geriatric and terminally ill patients. It was that compassion that inspired her advocacy and care for ill and injured veterans and their families.

Barbara was mother to Matthew and Mark Maldet, and doted on her two grandsons.
