In September I attended the National Fall Conference in Lexington, KY. The chairmen presented their programs full of information to the attendees. I want to thank the members of the state of Missouri for participating in my Community Service skit on "How to complete a good Community Service report". Each participant was dressed in a costume that corresponded with a category on the report. It was a lot of fun and everyone did a fantastic job. There was a question and answer session following the program with a lot of group discussion.

In February I attended the Mid-Winter Conference in Washington D.C. I was privileged to be present when DAV National Commander Whitehead addressed the Joint Committee on Veterans Affairs. I attended the seminars and they were all very informative. Twenty eight members from Missouri met face-to-face with our Senators and Representatives or their aides in a room at the Senate building to make it clear what DAV is fighting for. They all seemed to be very receptive to our issues.

I was scheduled to be the national representative for the State Conventions of North Dakota, Oregon and Florida but because of COVID-19 all convention travel was cancelled to ensure the safety of all national representatives. I was very disappointed but thankful that everyone would be safe.
